Tortugas Group takes responsibility for adopting good practice with regards to the environmental management of our activities.

In Tortugas Group, we are committed to the conservation of natural resources on the island of Holbox and therefore, look for an environmental, social, and corporate balance.

For this reason, we implement certain environmentally-friendly practices, which can be seen in our sustainability policy:

- ∞ We give preference to local suppliers.
- ∞ We have a waste reduction policy*
- ∞ We minimise the use of canned materials.
- ∞ We do not use PET or aluminium cans for soft drinks.
- ∞ We do not provide takeaway food in disposable containers (Styrofoam or polystyrene).
- ∞ We do not use straws.
- ∞ The beers we offer are made locally.
- ∞ We are committed to saving energy and water, which are scarce resources on the island.
- ∞ We comply with the legal framework and focus on continually improving our processes.
- ∞ We use electric transportation.
- ∞ We employ staff from different local communities.
- ∞ We promote and aid local cultural events in Holbox.

* Waste reduction policy

The main objective of the waste reduction policy is to minimise the quantity of waste we generate and define the minimum standards we should meet within the company:

- ∞ Minimise the quantity of waste produced.
- ∞ Reuse materials whenever possible.
- ∞ Separate waste in situ and in collaboration with similar companies, move waste to an authorised recycling plant in order to minimise the environmental impact.
